X Consent-Ban verification policy upon admission

1. Important Rules

- ① Comply with the rules and regulations of Japan while being enrolled in our school.
- ② Avoid late payment of school tuition fee and dormitory fee.
- ③ There will be no submission of false reports and false documents. Check and follow MANABI Japanese Language Institute's refund policy.
- ④ **【Short-term visa】** Agrees to have student visa application to be cancelled if attendance rate goes down to 90% when enrolled in the short-term Japanese language training.

2. Prohibited Rules

- ① 18 years old and below:
 - Staying overnight in other places aside from the accommodation provided by school.
 - Going out on 10:00pm until 5:00am without permission from guardian.
- ② Drinking and Smoking
 - According to the law smoking and drinking for minors (20 years old and below) are not allowed. Same with alcohol and cigarette possession.
- ③ On drugs
 - Possession and use.
- ④ Violence
 - Actions like violence, verbal abuse, damage to property and bullying. (Attacking a person physically and psychologically, or letting the person feel physical and psychological stresses)

3. Important Checklist

- ① **【Short-term visa】** Not allowed to do a part-time job, or do things that earn money.
- ② **【Short-term visa】** Subscribe for medical care, damage, injury and travel insurance on your own.

4. Others

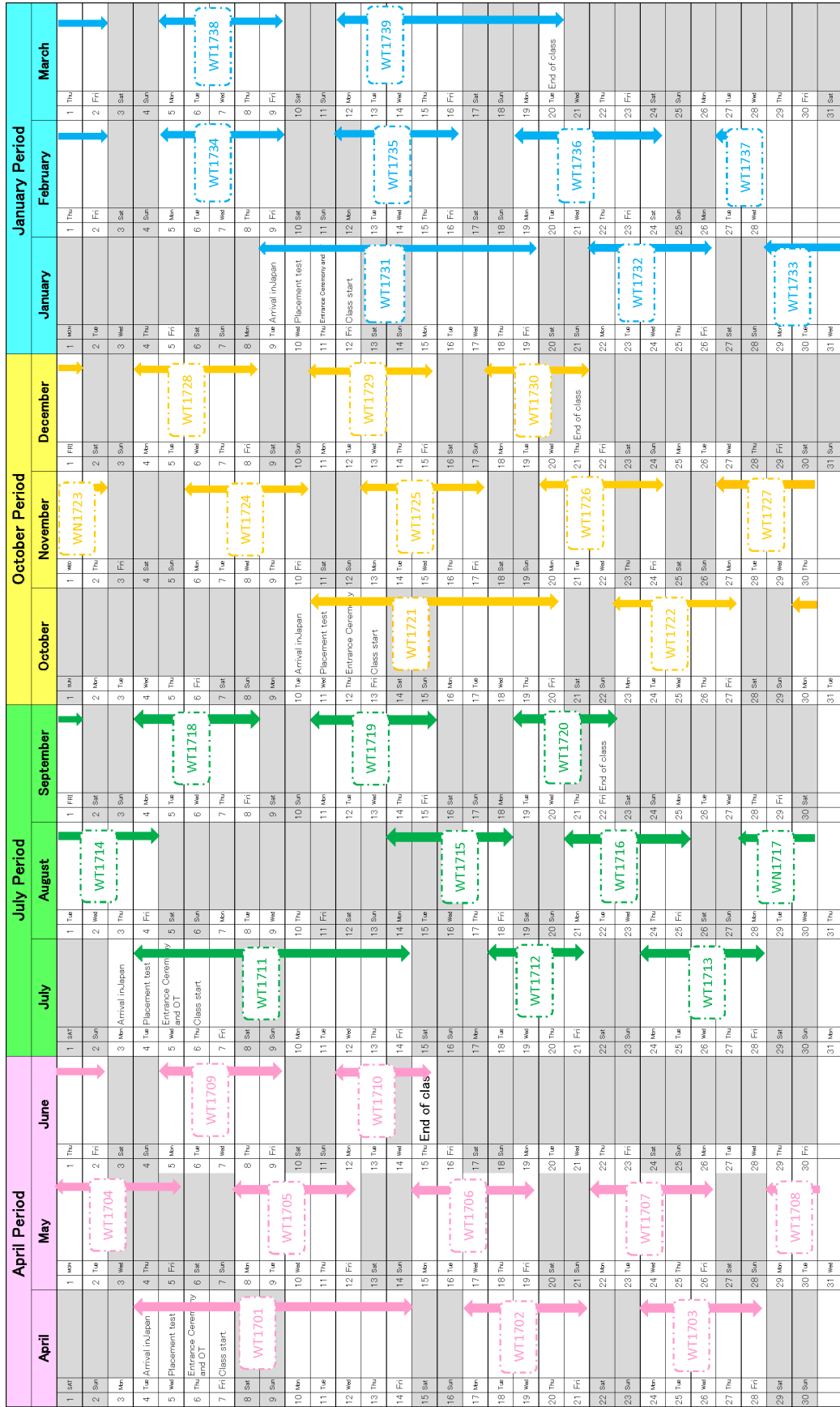
